This year's topics

1. Spatial and temporal flexibility of work practices

Staff representatives are invited to describe their Organisations' innovative systems with regard to:

- spatial work flexibility, and especially teleworking policies;

- temporal work flexibility, and especially flexi-time, time savings accounts and part-time work policies.

2. Pension scheme developments

It is now ten years since the Conference last exchanged views on pension issues. We therefore propose to look at the main changes to our pension schemes in the last few years, and also the creation of new schemes and how they are financed.

3. Mediation

A number of Organisations have introduced the idea of mediation as a means of averting conflicts or settling them amicably. You are invited to discuss this method of dispute settlement and outline its advantages and drawbacks.

If you wish to make a presentation on any of the three topics,

Presentations should not last more than 15 minutes and can be made either in English or French.
