The Secretariat Staff Committee (SSC)

O Consists of 5 Staff Representatives

O Is elected every two years by eligible staff members



The Secretariat Staff Committee (SSC)

O The mandate covers only representation of staff at the Secretariat, but the SSC tries to support colleagues in other duty stations by sharing advice and expertise as required.

O Presents a work plan to the Senior Management and discusses issues of concern on a regular basis

Mandate of the SSC

- O To represent and defend the interests of the staff;
- O To participate in identifying, examining and resolving issues connected to staff welfare and personnel policies concerning conditions of employment;
- O To make proposals with regard to the above issues for the consideration and discussion with the Senior Management.



Active Role

- Represent 385 staff
- Regular Meeting with Staff
- Meeting with Staff Representatives of other organizations to exchange knowledge and expertise
- Weekly meeting of the staff committee members to review and discuss staff issues
